AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Westminster Larger, #52

Q. 52. How was Christ exalted in his resurrection?

Christ was exalted in his resurrection, in that, not having seen corruption in death (of which it was not possible for him to be held), and having the very same body in which he suffered, with the essential properties thereof (but without mortality, and other common infirmities belonging to this life), really united to his soul, he rose again from the dead on the third day, by his own power; whereby he declared himself to be the Son of God, to have satisfied divine justice, to have vanguished death, and him that had the power of it, and to be Lord of quick and dead: all which he did publicly, as the head of his church, for their justification, quickening in grace, support against enemies, and to assure them of their resurrection from the dead at the last day.

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

Romans 6:9-12

We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.
