AFFIRMATION OF **F**AITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism #79-81

Q. 79. What is the tenth commandment?

A. The tenth commandment is, you shall not covet your neighbor's house, you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is you neighbor's.

Q. 80. What is required in the tenth commandment?

A. The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a right and charitable frame of spirit toward our neighbor, and all that is his.

Q. 81. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment? A. The tenth commandment forbids all discontentment with our own estate, envying or grieving at the good of our neighbor, and all unwarranted motions and affections to anything that is his.

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

Psalm 37:3-6

Trust in the LORD, and do good; dwell in the land and befriend faithfulness. Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act. He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.

Give us such great confidence in the gospel that we run joyfully to you in the midst of our weakness, placing our trust in you and in your goodness, and seeking after your will in all areas of our lives. Turn our hearts to you, we pray, in Jesus' name. Amen.
