The Apostles Creed

So then each of us will give an account of himself to God. Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

SILENT CONFESSION OF SIN Psalm 51:1-4 (In these moments, we individually come to God in prayer, meditating on these words, and silently confessing personal sins so that we may take hold of the forgiveness won for us by Christ, our Redeemer.)
